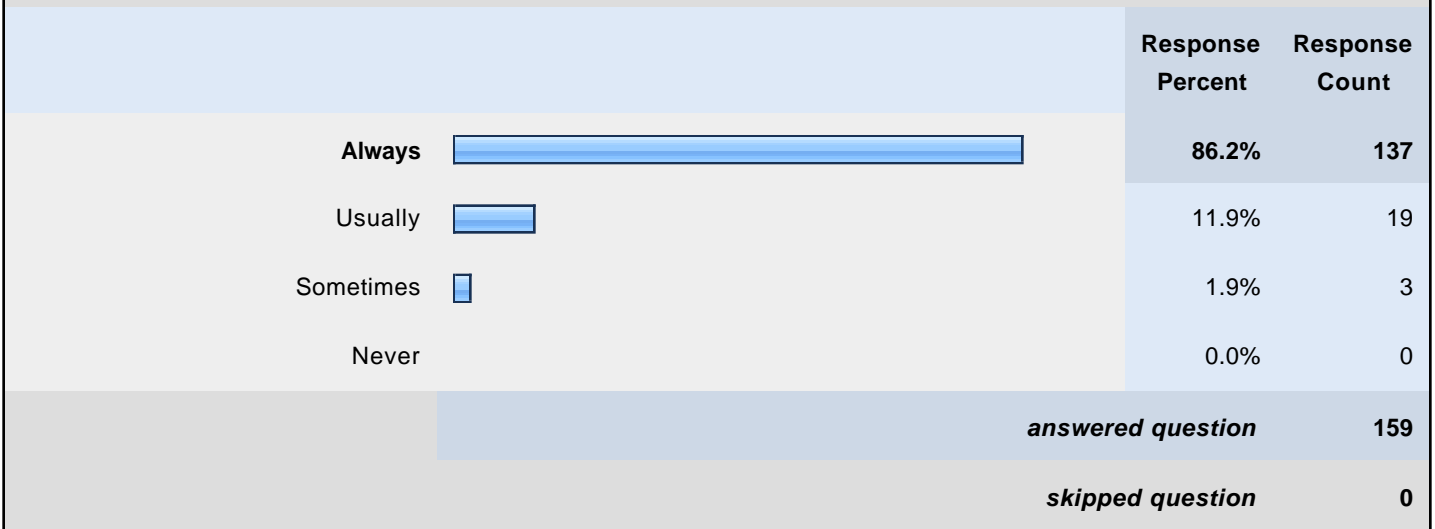

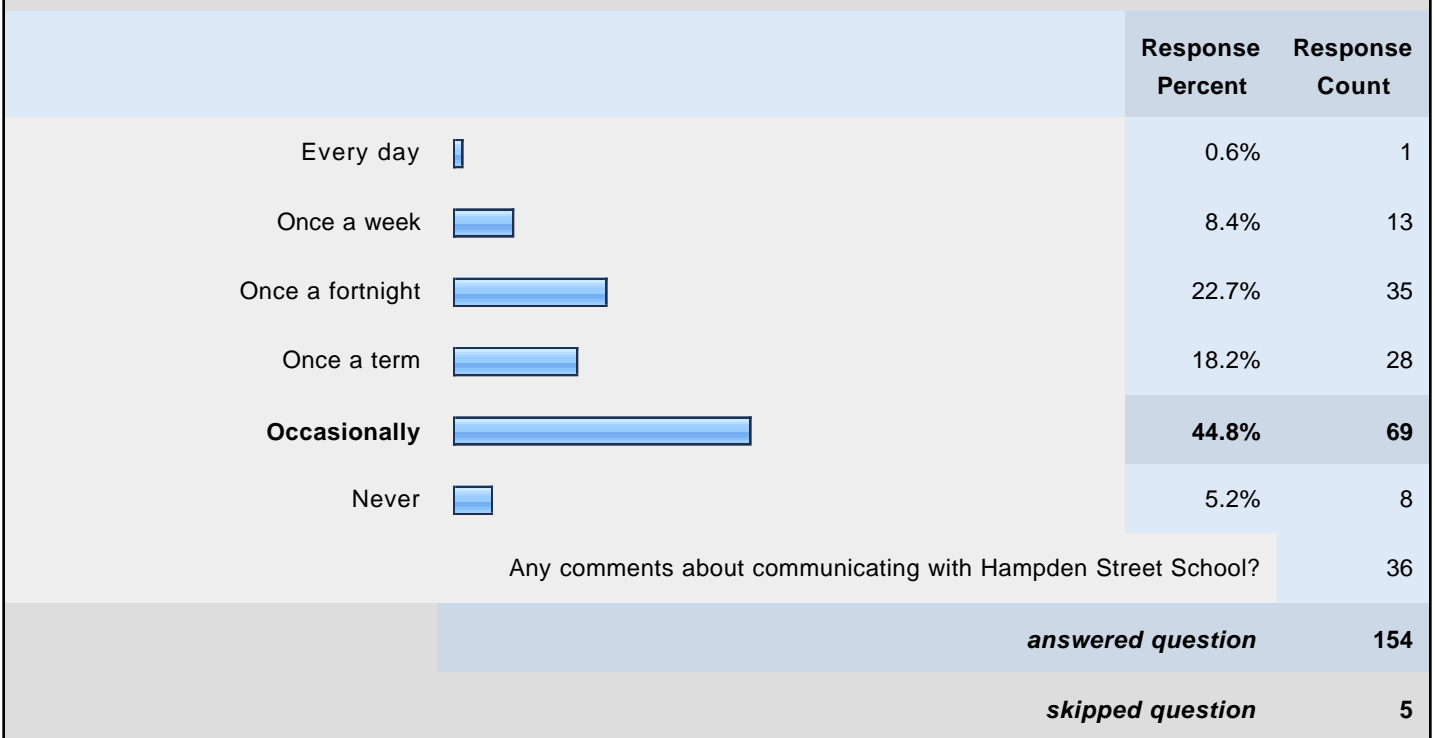


4. How often do you visit the school website?


